Section 3.1 Membership.

The members shall consist of the Owners of the Lots in the Premises. Membership is transferable only as provided in the Declaration or these Bylaws. The membership of a Lot Owner shall terminate upon the conveyance, transfer or other disposition of his interest in the Lot accomplished in accordance with the Declaration, whereupon his membership and any interest in the assets of the Association shall automatically transfer to and be vested in the successor in ownership. Membership is otherwise non-transferable. A

mortgage of a Lot or the grant of a security interest therein as security for an obligation shall not operate to transfer membership until a foreclosure of the mortgage or collateral subject to the security agreement.
